This is a game in which two groups compete around a boundary.

Practical use

This method allows the participants to work on the importance of the consultation

| | STEP 01 | STEP 02 |

| OBJECTIVES | | Game |
| PREPARATION OR PLAY TIME | 10 min | 15–20 min |
| ROLE | <p>The trainer organizes the two groups in any way he or she wants, but in a proportional way. The two groups take their places in the middle of the room</p> <p>The trainer draws a line between the two groups</p> <p>He gives a rope that is big enough to connect the two groups</p> | <p>The two groups compete by pulling the rope.</p> <p>The trainer referees and signals when one of the group members has crossed the line.</p> |
| POINT OF ATTENTION | | <p>Each member of the group must move closer together and pull the rope together to get all the rope on their side of the chalk line. When a person passes the line, he or she must leave the group.</p> |
| TOOLS | | Chalk, rope |
